## Bishop Gadsden Coronavirus (COVID-19) Statistics

*As of January 25, 2021*

We look forward to our vaccine clinic tomorrow, January 26, for those that received their first vaccine on Tuesday, December 29, which includes the majority of health care residents, and nearly 100 team members. Tomorrow's clinic will also serve many team members receiving their first dose. Dates for the remaining second dose vaccine clinics should be finalized by CVS in the coming weeks.

Our focus in the coming weeks is on achieving 100% of eligible residents and team members receiving both of their vaccine doses. We anticipate communicating operational changes to reflect our vaccination success in the near future.

This past week, we had one asymptomatic team member positive COVID-19 test on a non-health care culinary team member. This team member had not yet received their first dose of the vaccine, and last tested negative the previous week.

For the week of January 18 – January 22, Bishop Gadsden conducted 618 tests. Of those that were tested at Bishop Gadsden, we had three positive tests, giving us a percent positive rate of 0.5%.

We continue to see the reports of record-breaking days. According to data on the SCDHEC site for Monday, January 18 – Friday, January 22, the state of South Carolina had a percent positive rate of 25.5%, and the County of Charleston of 22.5%, according to SCDHEC website – <https://scdhec.gov/covid19/south-carolina-county-level-data-covid-19>
