Vaccine Update: We look forward to welcoming CVS to Bishop Gadsden for our vaccine clinic next Tuesday, February 16.

- Appointment cards for your second doses will be placed in your internal mail cubby, contact Katie Jayne at 843.406.6300 or katie.jayne@bishopgadsden.org should you have questions.
- When you arrive for your appointment, please bring your vaccination card, and a book for reading.
- At this time, we have not been informed of any potential shortages with CVS obtaining the Moderna vaccine.
- Preparing for your second dose - You may experience some side-effects for 24 – 36 hours following:

Pre-Vaccine: Drink plenty of fluids, dress lightly

Post Vaccine: Consider taking an over-the-counter medicine, such as ibuprofen or acetaminophen after the vaccine. **Per the CDC, taking these medicines it prior to receiving the vaccine could reduce the vaccine's effectiveness.**

Operational Changes: Please be sure to review the current phased-in approach to a YELLOW operational level. Copies are located at the Trawick Commons Concierge and on BGLife.
