## Bishop Gadsden Coronavirus (COVID-19) Statistics

*As of February 15, 2021*

Today, we report our first positive COVID-19 test since Monday, February 1. This positive is a health care culinary team member who has not received the COVID-19 vaccine, last tested negative on Thursday, February 11, and tested again this morning when they reported for their shift.

As required, all Myers Hall residents will be COVID-19 tested tomorrow, Tuesday, February 16, and again, on Tuesday, February 23, and the Frederick Dining Room will be temporarily closed during this testing period. Team members continue their twice-a-week testing.

Tomorrow, Tuesday, February 16, we welcome CVS for a vaccine clinic, where they will administer the remaining second doses to all eligible apartment and cottage residents, as well as many team members. This clinic will also allow for additional interested and new team members to receive their first dose. Our focus continues to be on having 100% of eligible residents and team members receiving both of their vaccine doses.

Starting on February 2, SCDHEC announced a change in how they will now report percent positive using the tests-over-tests method. Percent positive will be calculated by dividing all positive COVID-19 tests by the total number of COVID-19 tests (positive and negative), and then multiplying the result by 100 to get a percent. With the change, the public may notice a drop in the number representing percent positive. **That does not mean the level of spread in the community has decreased.**

During the week of February 8 – February 12, Bishop Gadsden conducted 544 tests with one positive test result. Using the same method outlined by SCDHEC above, the positivity rate at Bishop Gadsden is 0.18%.

For Monday, February 8 – Friday, Friday 12, the state of South Carolina had a percent positive rate of 9.6%, and the County of Charleston of 9.9%, according to SCDHEC website – <https://scdhec.gov/covid19/south-carolina-county-level-data-covid-19>
