Bishop Gadsden Coronavirus (COVID-19) Statistics

As of February 8, 2021

We have not had any new positive COVID-19 cases since last Monday, February 1.

Our vaccine clinics continue to be successful. Last Tuesday, February 2, more than 450 second doses were administered to apartment and cottage residents and team members, as well as many initial first doses. With additional clinics scheduled in the coming weeks, our focus continues to be on having 100% of eligible residents and team members receiving both of their vaccine doses.

Starting on February 2, SCDHEC announced a change in how they will now report percent positive using the tests-over-tests method. Percent positive will be calculated by dividing all positive COVID-19 tests by the total number of COVID-19 tests (positive and negative), and then multiplying the result by 100 to get a percent.

With the change, the public may notice a drop in the number representing percent positive. **That does not mean the level of spread in the community has decreased.** Percent positive will appear to be lower only because it is calculated differently.

During the week of February 1 – February 5, Bishop Gadsden conducted 629 tests with one positive test result. Using the same method outlined by SCDHEC above, the positivity rate at Bishop Gadsden is 0.15%.

For Monday, February 1 – Friday, Friday 5, the state of South Carolina had a percent positive rate of 10.3%, and the County of Charleston of 10.5%, according to SCDHEC website – <https://scdhec.gov/covid19/south-carolina-county-level-data-covid-19>
